Bio-toilets prevented corrosion: Vaishnaw

All mainline coaches carrying passengers are equipped with bio-toilets that have prevented corrosion of rail fittings caused by human waste, Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw informed the Lok Sabha on Wednesday.

In a written reply to questions on the installation of bio-toilets in trains, he said the Indian Railways has adopted a zero-discharge bio-toilet system for its coaches to eliminate direct discharge of human waste onto railway tracks and to improve hygiene and cleanliness.

"The work has been taken up in mission mode by the Indian



Railways," the minister said.

"At present, all passenger-carrying mainline coaches equipped with bio-toilets have been provisioned with bio-toilets. This has also prevented corrosion of rail fittings due to human waste."

IITstudy maps India's flash flood hotspots

Flash floods in the Himalayas are primarily influenced by the region's land features, while those occurring along the west coast and in central India are driven by factors that affect water flow, a map of hotspots across the country developed by researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar shows.

Three-fourths of flash floods occurring across the country are triggered due to extreme rainfall and moist conditions of the ground caused by recent, prolonged rains, the study published in the journal 'npj Natural Hazards' found. The remaining one-fourth is solely driven by extreme rainfall, it said. The extreme weather event is highly local, in terms of area impacted and spans



a short duration between when rainfall starts and when flooding peaks, which is usually under six hours, according to the India Meteorological Department (IMD).

75% attendance rule for board exams strictly followed: CBSE to school

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has warned schools to strictly adhere to the 75 per cent attendance requirement for students appearing for board exams.

The CBSE offers a 25 per cent relaxation only in cases of emergencies such as medical emergency, participation in national or international sports events and other serious reasons, if supported by the necessary documents or record.

In a letter to schools, CBSE Examination Controller Sanyam Bhardwaj said: "All students and



parents must be made aware of the mandatory 75 per cent attendance requirement criteria and the potential consequences of not meeting this criteria.

Government refuses Bihar electoral roll debate in Parliament

Turning down the Opposition's demand for a discussion of electoral roll revision in Bihar, the Government asserted in the Lok Sabha that matters pending before the judiciary cannot be discussed on the floor of the House.

Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge, however, cited past rulings by the Chair to urge deputy chairman Harivansh to allow a discussion on the special intensive revision of electoral rolls in Bihar and asserted that it is of fundamental importance to our democracy.

Parliament on Wednesday witnessed logjam with repeated disruptions and adjournments amid continued din by Opposition on the issue of Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in Bihar.

Speaking in the Lok Sabha, Union Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju stressed that rules of the Lok Sabha do not allow sub-judice matters to be discussed in the House. He also pointed out that the functioning of autonomous

institutions such as the Election Commission cannot be discussed in Parliament.

"The Government has been very open to taking up discussion on any matter. However, any discussion in the Parliament has to be in accordance with constitutional provisions and also in accordance with the rules as prescribed in the procedure and conduct of business in the Lok Sabha.

On the issue of intensive revision of electoral rolls in Bihar for which they (opposition members) are disturbing the House from first day of the session, we all know that the matter is under consideration of the

Supreme court and as such it is sub-judice and a hence a discussion cannot be held on the subject," Rijiju said.

Rijiju underlined that the issue relates to the functioning of the Election

Commission of India, which is an autonomous body.

"In the past, it has been clearly established in this House itself that matters falling under the domain of the Election Commission of India cannot be discussed in this House," he said.

Both the houses were adjourned for the day after repeated disruption.

Kharge, in a letter to the deputy chairman, said that on July 21, 2023, the then chairman of the Rajya Sabha had given a ruling that "...this House is entitled to discuss everything under the planet with one restriction..."

The Congress president said the Chair had added that "this one restriction" relates to the

conduct of any judge of the Supreme Court or of a high court in the discharge of his ties"... except upon a motion for presenting an address to the President praying for the removal of the judge...". Further, he claimed that the chairman had ruled that "...the concept of sub-judice is totally misconceived..."

"You will undoubtedly appreciate that the Chair is a conti-nuing entity. You yourself have quoted rulings given by the Chair over the past

many years in support of some of your decisions. It is clear from this ruling of the Chair that the Rajya Sabha is entitled to discuss the issue of revision of electoral rolls, which is of fundamental importance in our democracy," Kharge said in his letter.

The Congress chief said the Special Intensive Review of the electoral rolls is being undertaken by the Election Commission first in Bihar and is to be taken up in West

Bengal, Assam and other states. "I, therefore, on my own behalf and behalf of the Opposition parties in Rajya Sabha, am writing to request you to immediately allow a discussion on this issue that is of paramount concern to crores of voters, especially those belonging to the weaker sections of the society," Kharge said. Opposition parties have been demanding a discussion on the special intensive revision of electoral rolls in Bihar and have been protest-

ing against the exercise in both houses of Parliament.

The Government has said the matter cannot be discussed on the floor of the House as it is sub-judice and deals with the functioning of the Election Commission, which is an autonomous institution. Parliament has not been able to conduct any significant legislative business ever since it met for the Monsoon session on July 21 due to opposition protests over the SIR issue.

Stop destruction of 1,742 hectares of forest in Chhattisgarh: Brinda Karat to Centre

Communist Party of India (Marxist) leader Brinda Karat on Wednesday called on the Centre to halt a coal project in Chhattisgarh that threatens to devastate approximately 1,742 hectares of dense forest land, claiming that at least 4.5 lakh trees would be felled if the project proceeds.

In her letter to Bhupender Yadav, the Minister for Environment, Forest, and Climate Change, the veteran CPI(M) leader said there is no "public interest" involved in the project as claimed, "only the exploitation of mineral resources for private gain".

"I am writing to you to strongly oppose and to request your intervention to reverse the destructive decision of the Chhattisgarh Forest department to give the green signal for the operationalisation of the Kente Extension Coal Project, which requires the destruction of 1742 hectares of dense forest land," Karat stated.

Karat's concerns follow an inspection by the Surguja District Forest Officer in June. She pointed out that the coal project, part of the larger Hasdeo-Arand region initiative, was given to a Rajasthan Government-owned power utility and the former Rajasthan Government had set up a joint venture with Adani Enterprises called Parsa Kente Collieries Limited, where Adani holds a 74 per cent stake.

"This company was appointed the mine developer cum operator of the Hasdeo-Parsa coal project. Records have shown that a substantial amount of coal mined under this venture has been diverted to the private company's power projects in the name of use of 'rejected coal'," Karat said.

She asserted this is relevant since the reasoning given for the clearance of the Kente Extension Coal

Project was framed as being in 'public interest'.

"There is no public interest involved, only the exploitation of mineral resources for private gain," she said.

Karat warned that the project, if implemented, would exacerbate the existing environmental damage in areas already affected by mining activities.

"According to the official inspection report, at least 4.5 lakh trees are going to be felled. These are in the dense forest, which is full of indigenous trees critical for carbon sequestration. Open-cast mining in this region has already destroyed thousands of trees, polluted the waters, and the ground soil," she said.

The CPI(M) leader alleged that the projects are being taken up, ignoring the opinions of the gram sabhas involved and the provisions of the constitution and legal frameworks that make consent of the gram sabhas mandatory.

She also highlighted that open-cast mining impacts a much wider geographical area than just the project site, and even if human habitation is sparse in the immediate vicinity, many neighbouring villages will be significantly affected.

"Earlier, more than 1500 written objections from local communities were given to the Government. But these have been ignored," she noted.

Karat reminded the minister of a past statement he made regarding a Forest Survey of India report, in which he indicated that "forest cover is lost due to titles being given under the FRA, 2006, and stringent protection measures are required."
