Israeli forces kill new Hamas leader in Gaza

Israel said on Wednesday that it targeted and killed the new leader of Hamas' military wing during airstrikes in Gaza City less than two weeks after it killed his predecessor.

Israel's Defence Minister Israel Katz and the Israeli military said the strikes, which were carried out on Tuesday, killed Mohammed Odeh.

Family members of a man called Mohammed Odeh said he was killed in the strike, but did not confirm he was the leader of the military wing. Hamas has not commented. Katz called him "one of the architects" of the



October 7, 2023, attacks that triggered over two years of war in Gaza and said it was the fourth time Israel has killed the head of Hamas' military wing since that massacre. Izz al-Din al-Haddad, the previous head, was killed on May 16. At least three

people were killed and 12 injured in Tuesday's strike, which took place on the eve of Eid al-Adha, a major Muslim holiday.

"We pledged to eliminate everyone who led the October 7 massacre and this is what we will do: they are

all bound to die, everywhere," Katz wrote on X on Wednesday. "We pledged that Hamas will not hold civilian or military rule."

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, who is preparing for elections in the fall, also threatened that Israel will target everyone involved in the October 7, 2023, attack.

A grim Eid in Gaza

The attack came as Muslims prepared for Eid al-Adha, normally a joyous time of family gatherings and large meals.

The holiday once again is subdued this year in Gaza, where the vast majority of people remain displaced and live in tents or temporary shelters after a devastating

war. Around 90 per cent of Gaza's more than 2 million people have lost their homes, according to UN estimates, with most of them now sheltering in huge tent camps with rat infestations and pools of sewage. They are dependent on aid to survive.

Eid al-Adha, or "Feast of Sacrifice," is an Islamic holiday celebrated by millions of Muslims across the globe. The four-day holiday, which begins during the Hajj pilgrimage, is also known for being a joyous occasion during which families gather, and children are given new clothes and gifts.

"This is not Eid ... we're dead," said Mahmoud Sager, a displaced man from Khan

Younis, who described people as being distressed by the ongoing human suffering and killings in the territory.

In Khan Younis and Gaza City, amid destroyed buildings, including a ruined mosque, people gathered for Eid prayers with few signs of celebration beyond a few clusters of balloons lining one street. Tahrir al-Khatib said the joy that accompanies Eid has been silenced in Gaza. "There's no Eid.

My children were killed. Eid is only for the people who lost no one," said Ayda Al-Banna, a displaced woman from Gaza , who prayed Eid Fragile ceasefire holds in Gaza A ceasefire reached between Israel and Hamas last October remains fragile. (AP)

Climate change major challenge for Himalayas: Nepal President

Sustainable tourism, responsible mountaineering and conservation of the Himalayan environment are the defining challenges of the day, Nepal's President Ramchandra Paudel said on Wednesday. Addressing the 'Everest Summiters Summit - 2026' organised in Kathmandu, Paudel said Mount Everest was not only a geographical identity of Nepal but also the pride, prestige and an invaluable natural heritage of the country. "The country's economy has benefitted from the tourism sector through the conservation, promotion, publicity and balanced use of these assets," he said.

Paudel stated that global warming, the impacts of climate change and the

accumulation of garbage in mountaineering areas have emerged as major challenges of the modern world.

"Addressing these issues and conserving the environment and biodiversity in the Everest region, while making mountaineering safe, sustainable and technology-friendly, requires additional efforts and cooperation from all sides," he said. He pointed out that conservation, promotion and balanced utilisation of Himalayan resources directly support Nepal's tourism industry and broader economic development.

Mukunda Prasad Niraula, secretary of the Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Civil Aviation, also expressed concerns about climate change and its impact on Mount Everest and other mountains of Nepal. (PTI)

5 found alive in flooded Laos cave; 2 still missing

Five villagers stuck in a flooded cave in central Laos for more than a week were found alive, rescuers said Wednesday, but two others are missing.

The villagers entered the cave in Xaisomboun province on May 19, but heavy rain triggered flash flooding that blocked the exit and trapped seven people, according to Lao and Thai rescue teams involved in the operation.

Bounkham Luanglath of the Lao organisation Rescue Volunteer for People, which has been working closely with local authorities in the rescue efforts, told said that

five people were found safe and alive, but two more are still missing, and the search for them will continue.

"I'm still shaking. Our team made it happen," he said in a voice message. A video posted by a Thai rescue group involved in the mission appeared to show the moment divers emerged from the water and discovered the trapped villagers.

In the footage, the villagers, each wearing a headlamp, were sitting on a rock surrounded by floodwater. Other videos showed rescuers inside and outside the cave cheering, jumping around and hugging each other in joy after the discovery. Rescue workers from

neighbouring Thailand arrived at the site over the weekend.

The cave is located in a rugged, remote area in Xaisomboun province's in Vientiane.

Rescuers at the scene have detailed on social media the challenging mountainous terrain and heavy rain that have hampered their work.

Videos shared online by Thai rescuers showed that reaching the cave's entrance requires a steep hike of roughly 4 kilometres . The entrance is also steep and rocky, and barely wide enough for a single person at a time to climb through.

Spanish police raid PM Sanchez's party headquarters

The raid on the office in central Madrid is another blow to the party of Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez, whose Socialists have been hammered by a series of corruption scandals.

Hungary's parliament votes to remain member of ICC

Hungary's parliament voted on Wednesday to remain a member of the International Criminal Court (ICC), reversing a decision by the previous Government of Viktor Orban to withdraw from the global tribunal.

Orban's Government announced last year that Hungary would quit the ICC, the world's only permanent global court for war crimes and genocide, shortly after a state visit by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu which went ahead despite an ICC warrant for his arrest over alleged war crimes in connection with Israel's war in the Gaza Strip. The ICC and other international organizations criticized Orban's Government for failing to detain Netanyahu. Orban accused the ICC of becoming a "political court."

Hungary's withdrawal has been set to take effect on June 2. The bill to reverse the decision, which was sub-

mitted on Monday by Prime Minister Peter Magyar, states that in order to maintain international peace and protect human rights "it is essential that those who commit the most serious international crimes be held accountable before an international judicial forum." It adds: "To this end, it is necessary to maintain Hungary's

participation in the Statute of the International Criminal Court."

The bill was passed largely along party lines, with 133 lawmakers from Magyar's ruling Tiszta party voting to approve, 37 votes against and five abstentions. The ICC's oversight body, the Assembly of States Parties, welcomed

Hungary's return. In a statement on Monday in anticipation of the vote, the organi-

zation said it "congratulates the Government of Hungary for this important decision."
