Sood orders action to tackle Bhalswa landfill pollution

Delhi Urban Development Minister Ashish Sood on Thursday inspected the Bhalswa Landfill Site and directed officials to expedite efforts to eliminate the city's "garbage mountains." Sood also ordered the immediate installation of six anti-smog guns and 12 water sprinklers to tackle rising dust and air pollution in the area. During his visit, Sood reviewed ongoing biomining, waste processing, and pollution control measures alongside senior officials of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) and other departments. He assessed the functioning of trommel machines and the arrangements for the scientific processing and disposal of both new and legacy waste. "Approximately 4,000 metric tonnes of fresh waste are dumped at Bhalswa daily. Both new and old waste must be processed scientifically to prevent further pollution," he said.

Revamping industrial areas to bring down pollution: Sirsa

Delhi Industries Minister Manjinder Singh Sirsa on Thursday said the Government is redeveloping industrial areas to not only improve basic infrastructure but also reduce dust pollution. The minister chaired a review meeting with senior officials of Delhi State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation (DSIIDC) regarding the status of maintenance and redevelopment works across industrial areas. The discussions covered such areas as Patparganj Industrial Area, Okhla Industrial Estate Phase III, Wazirpur, Naraina, Mayapuri Ph-I & II, Mangolpuri, Kirti Nagar, Badli, GT Karnal Road, DLF Moti Nagar, Okhla, Jhilmil, Rajasthani Udyog Nagar, and Lawrence Road. During the review, the officials apprised the minister about the three-tier categorisation of industrial areas based on the urgency of road development and maintenance – satisfactory, medium, and poor – ensuring a targeted approach towards phased redevelopment.

Cabinet approves jobs for kin of 1984 anti-Sikh riot victims

The Delhi Government has approved a long-pending policy to offer compassionate employment to dependents of those killed in the 1984 anti-Sikh riots. The decision was taken at a Cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Wednesday. Officials said the move marks a major step towards delivering long-overdue relief and recognition to families who have waited more than four decades for justice and rehabilitation. The Chief Minister said the new policy would fast-track pending employment cases that have remained unresolved since a Cabinet decision in 2007. "For the past 18 years, the process could not be completed due to administrative hurdles. This policy introduces a clear, structured, and time-bound framework to ensure that no rightful claimant is left behind," she said.

Under the new policy, the dependents of riot victims who are now above 50 years of age and unable to work will be allowed to nominate a younger family member. The nominee can be a son, daughter,



daughter-in-law, or son-in-law. The provision was included to ensure that the benefit of employment reaches the families in a meaningful way. "This clause acknowledges that many dependents are now elderly and unable to take up jobs themselves. The option to nominate a younger family member ensures that assistance truly supports the household," an official from the Chief Minister's Office said.

The policy also includes relaxations in age and educational qualifications. These will apply in accordance with the

guidelines of the Delhi High Court and existing service rules. A transparent verification and grievance redressal system has been built into the policy to ensure accountability. Departments will be assigned clear roles for processing and approving applications within specific timelines.

The Chief Minister said the government's aim is not only to provide financial assistance but also to restore the dignity of families who suffered in the violence. "Our Government is determined to ensure that no eligible family faces further

delays. By extending opportunities to the next generation, we seek to uphold their right to livelihood and honour," she said. Officials said the Cabinet's approval closes a long chapter of administrative delays. Many applications for compassionate employment have been pending since the mid-2000s, with families repeatedly petitioning the Government.

The new framework will reopen those cases and establish a single-window system for processing fresh applications. "The idea is to make the process humane, transparent, and time-bound," an official said.

The 1984 anti-Sikh riots, which broke out after the assassination of then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi, left thousands dead and displaced across Delhi. Families of victims have been seeking justice, compensation, and rehabilitation for decades.

In 2006, the Delhi Government had announced a compensation package and employment assistance for victims' dependents. But the implementation stalled over verification disputes and lack of a clear policy. The 2025 decision aims to remove those barriers permanently.

Govt to soon launch DTC bus services with NCR: CM

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Thursday announced that the Government will soon resume DTC bus services connecting the national Capital with NCR cities.

She flagged off another inter-state electric bus route operated by the Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC), running from the Kashmere Gate Bus Terminal to the Sonipat Bus Stand. The newly introduced electric buses are equipped with air-conditioning, CCTV cameras, panic buttons, and GPS systems.

The CM announced that the Government will soon resume DTC bus services connecting Delhi with adjoining NCR cities as she flagged off three inter-State electric buses bound for Sonipat. Earlier, on the occasion of

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday celebrations during the Seva Pakhwada, the chief minister had inaugurated the first inter-State electric bus service between Delhi and Baraut.

She said the Delhi Government is reviving inter-State bus services between Delhi and NCR cities that had been discontinued several years ago. She added that this initiative will provide citizens with accessible and convenient public transport options, reduce traffic congestion, and help curb pollution.

"The new DTC electric buses are equipped with state-of-the-art facilities, including air-conditioning, CCTV cameras, panic buttons, and GPS systems. These buses will ensure safer and more comfortable travel for passengers," the CM said.

Ceiling collapse in Noida's Ram Vihar society sparks safety concerns

A retired Army officer and war veteran, General Ashok Mehta, has written to the Chief Executive Officer of the Noida Authority, Lokesh, seeking urgent intervention after a major portion of the ceiling in his flat collapsed last September. The incident took place in Ram Vihar Society (RVS), Sector 30, Noida – an AWHO (Army Welfare Housing Organisation) complex where the 88-year-old officer and his wife were living since 1995.

In his letter dated October 27, 2025, addressed to the CEO of Noida Authority, Sector 6, General Mehta described the collapse of the ceiling as the culmination of "repeated

patchy and perfunctory repair work done by the society." The damage, he wrote, stemmed from recurrent leakage and seepage from the terrace, which the society had failed to repair adequately despite its multiple interventions in 2015 and 2022-23.

According to General Mehta, on returning from abroad on September 22, 2025, he discovered that large portions of the ceiling – including reinforced cement concrete and masonry – had collapsed in one of the rooms of his top-floor flat (B-707). "The ceiling collapse could have led to fatalities or injuries. Luckily, we were not in the flat," he stated in his complaint.

The retired officer said that after meeting the society's

Board of Management (BOM) on September 24, he was informed that a structural examination of the entire society's roofing and internal ceiling had been ordered and that cost estimates for repairs were awaited. However, despite repeated reminders via letters dated September 28, October 5, and October 9, and multiple WhatsApp messages to the society's President, Brig Y Mukherjee, there was "no response" except for a general circular on October 3 by the Secretary, Col Avinash Verma.

An earlier WhatsApp message to him by General Mehta on January 8, 2023, when he was Secretary, read, "To remind you of the rooftop ceiling leaking a second time."



On this October 23, the BOM informed him that under society rules, owners are responsible for internal repairs while the RVS handles external ones – a distinction General Mehta termed "irrelevant" in the case of top-floor flats. The validity of this rule, apparently transacted in the AGM, is itself questionable. "The internal damage was a direct consequence of leakage from the terrace, for which the society had twice previously carried out repairs. The BOM did not tell Gen Mehta on 24 Sep that he would have to do internal repairs. The society's negligence has made my flat structurally unsafe," he wrote.

General Mehta further highlighted that the terrace

above his flat is a common area controlled and locked by the society, to which he has no personal access. His neighbour in B 708, Jamwal, a civil engineer, had suffered similar internal and external damage. "There is a real danger in the future that the roof could collapse due to the negligence of the Ram Vihar Society," he warned, adding that the situation has caused him "undue strain and distress." The present office bearers say there is no record of society having carried out any repairs, when the permanent staff will vouch for it.

He has now requested the Noida Authority to direct the RVS management headed by President Brig. Mukherjee, to carry out immediate internal

and external structural repairs and ensure water-proofing of the terrace to prevent further damage. RVS is otherwise a harmonious habitat except for the whimsical and ad hoc behaviour of some elected officials.

The complaint concludes by underscoring that this is not an isolated case of minor seepage, but a serious structural failure that threatens the safety and security of other residents, which is the cardinal responsibility of management/officials.

The Ram Vihar Society could not be reached for immediate comment. The Noida Authority is expected to take cognisance of the matter following General Mehta's formal written complaint.

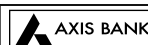
